	<p>Section 1. <u>Legislative</u></p>
<p>SC 301, 407, 510, 511, 964 Title 22 Sec. 17.1</p>	<p>The Board shall exercise its rule-making power by adopting Board procedures and policies for the organization and operation of the Intermediate Unit. Those procedures and policies which are not dictated by the statutes, or regulations of the State Board, or ordered by a court of competent authority may be adopted, amended or repealed at any meeting of the Board.</p> <p>The Board may, upon a majority vote, cause to suspend at any time the operation of a Board procedure or policy, provided the suspension does not conflict with legal requirements; such suspension shall be effective until the next meeting of the Board, unless an earlier time is specified in the motion to suspend.</p> <p>Board procedures shall be adopted, amended or repealed by a majority vote of the Board.</p>
<p>Pol. 006</p>	<p>Board policies shall be adopted, amended or repealed by a majority vote of the Board.</p>
<p>Pol. 007</p>	<p>The adoption, modification, repeal or suspension of a Board procedure or policy shall be recorded in the minutes of the Board meeting. All current procedures and policies shall be maintained in the Board Policy Manual and disseminated appropriately.</p>
	<p>Section 2. <u>Executive</u></p>
<p>SC 963, 964, 965 Pol. 302</p>	<p>The Board shall exercise its executive power by the appointment of an Executive Director, who shall enforce the statutes of the Commonwealth, the regulations of the State Board of Education, the policies of the Board, and all other applicable laws and regulations.</p>
