



WHAT IS FUSION FLEX?

- Curriculum for Kindergarten through Grade 12
- Ability to decide on a **core** subject and grade level curriculum while allowing teachers to add their own creativity and style
- Instructed by your district professional staff
- Developed by experts such as IU1 Curriculum Specialist and certified teachers
- Aligned to PA Standards
- Content includes:
 - o 4 Core Subject Areas (3-5), ELA and Math (K-2)
 - o Core curriculum including electives (6-12)
- Allows for *flexibility* in instruction, can be used as stand-alone, online curriculum OR as a supplement to face-to-face instruction in a flipped classroom
- Content is *editable*, district staff can modify courses and include district resources as needed.
- Engaging features and activities
- Content can be delivered via Moodle and/or Google Classroom. Districts can choose the option that best fits their individual school/classroom needs.

FUSION FLEX NON-MEMBERS

- Management and Curriculum
- \$15,000/year annually or \$2,000/month plus one-time \$1,000 for two days of professional development
- Commit by July 15, 2020

New Districts for combined Fusion and Fusion Flex:

- Three-year commitment at \$10,000/year for membership.
- If you want to join Fusion in addition to Fusion Flex we will waive the first \$10,000 of our Consortium membership fee
- Fusion is better suited to meet the needs of your full and part-time cyber students.
- If you commit to three years prior to July 1, we will charge:
 - Year 1: \$0 Fusion + \$12,500 Fusion Flex
 - Year 2: \$10,000 Fusion + \$10,000 Fusion Flex
 - Year 3: \$10,000 Fusion + \$10,000 Fusion Flex

FUSION CONSORTIUM MEMBERS

- Existing consortium members
- Full time online cyber students directed by district or by parents that want students in cyber
- Full time cyber courses offered at a per course cost
- Tech packages available
- Consortium membership is \$10,000/year for three years

Existing consortium members:

- Members can utilize Fusion Flex at \$10,000/year
- Commitment by July 1

Benefit of being a FULL Fusion Program Member:

- Management of program done by district OEAs in partnership with IU1
- Monthly meetings
- Lower per course costs for Fusion whether semester, full year, or credit recovery
